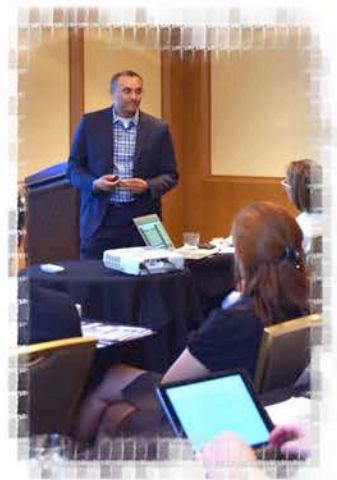

### Dr. Mayoor Patel, DDS, MS

Dr. Mayoor Patel received his dental degree from the University of Tennessee in 1994 and subsequently completed a one year residency in Advanced Education in General Dentistry (AEGD). He also earned a Masters in Science from Tufts University in 2011 in the area of Craniofacial Pain and Dental Sleep Medicine. Dr. Patel has earned a Fellowship in the American Academy of

Craniofacial Pain, the International College of Craniomandibular Orthopedics & Academy of General Dentistry, in addition to being a Diplomate in the American Academy of Pain Management and American Board of Craniofacial Pain. In 2003, he limit his practice to the treatment of TMJ Disorders, Headaches, Facial Pain, Sleep Apnea and Snoring. He has published two consumer books on pain and sleep as well as written numerous textbook chapters. Dr. Patel lectures on topics of orofacial pain and dental sleep medicine both nationally and internationally.



### Dr. Terry Bennett, DMD

Dr. Bennett received his dental degree from the University of Louisville School of Dentistry in 1977. Dr. Bennett started his private practice that same year. He soon developed an interest in treating patients with chronic head, neck and facial pain disorders. Since 1990 his practice has been exclusively devoted to the treatment of Temporomandibular-related disorders, snoring, sleep apnea, and bruxism.

To stay up to date on the latest procedures, Dr. Bennett has attended national meetings including extensive post-graduate and continuing education courses. He has accumulated more than 2,500 hours pertaining to TMJ disorders, Obstructive Sleep Apnea, Orthopedics, Orthodontics, and Craniofacial Orthopedics. Dr. Bennett has been an invited lecturer to other doctors on TMJ disorders and snoring/sleep apnea.
